## Wood Carving Jozsa

In Hungary people do not have money, television, etc. and sit around nights with nothing to do, so they carve. In the old days in a combat, they would use clubs carved with designs on the handles because a blow would really smart. When they buried the bodies, they would stick the staff in the dirt as a grave marker. About 200 years ago, religious symbolism was placed on them. The top would be a star, then the church steeple, then the X which is the Greek letter for Christ. Below would be a flower design for the eucharist and the host for the blessed sacrament.

The art of relief carving is to use angle cuts rather than deep straight cuts. The art is in removing minimal wood while appearing to be quite deep.

Red cedar resin reacts with metal and dulls blades.

Parting tool and dye brush for coloring while steaming the wood.

The first test of how good your art is the answer to the question, "Would you want to take this home if it were free?" The reward is when you can see that people are moved by your work.

## CARVING

Always cut into the solid wood, not into the weak wood.

Cut along the grain, not against the grain.

By cutting away from the ridge you can maintain the sharp edge.

Once you have carved, don't do any sanding because you will take away from the shape.

All of carving is nothing more than removing little triangles.

Always draw on the wood the design before carving.

Carve at least ten or fifteen minutes every day or you have to start over.

Make sure you have good sharp knives and good wood.
